- What can we know about the eternal relationship of God?



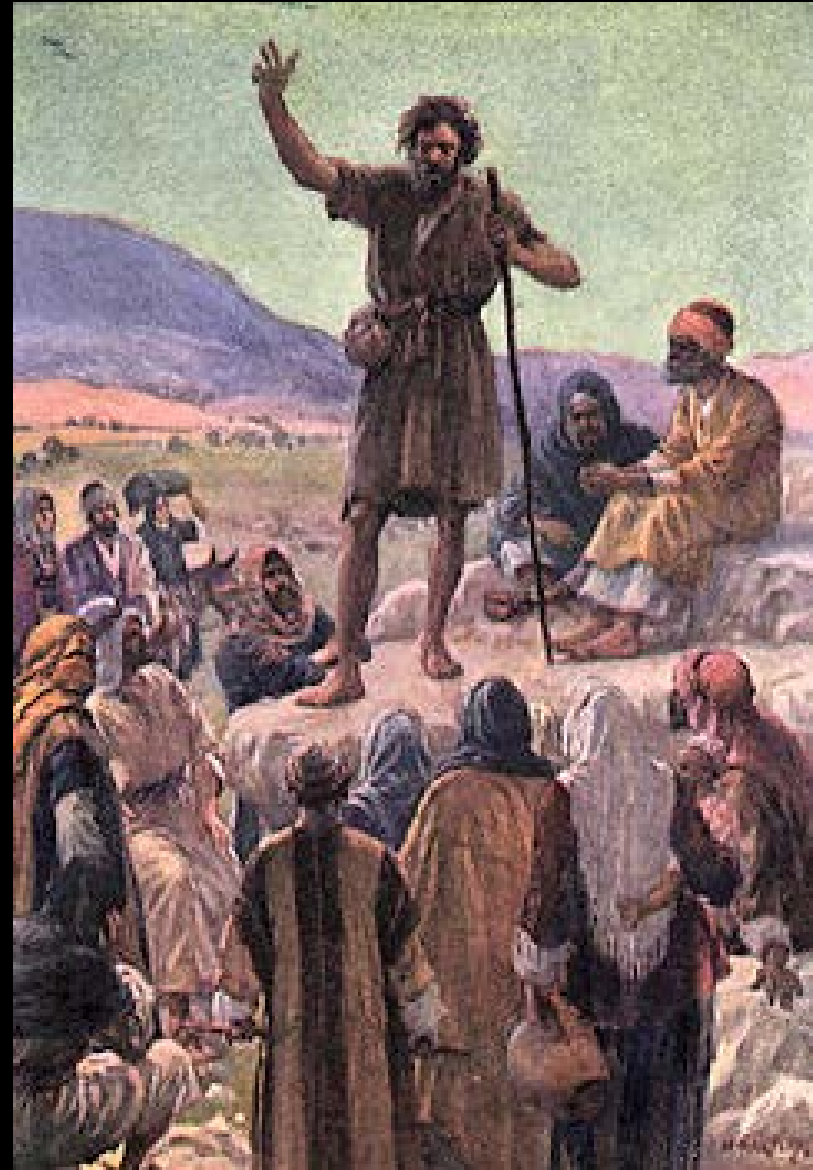
**II. He is the

- How has Jesus brought light into your life?



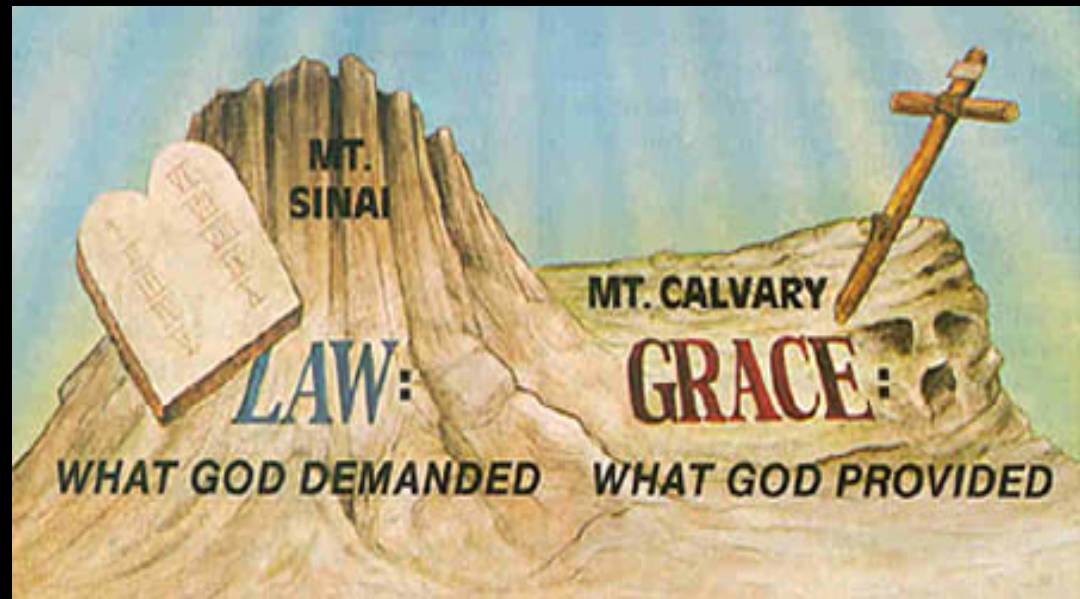


**IV. The Word was
