- Why is it so important for us to know that we are not in control?

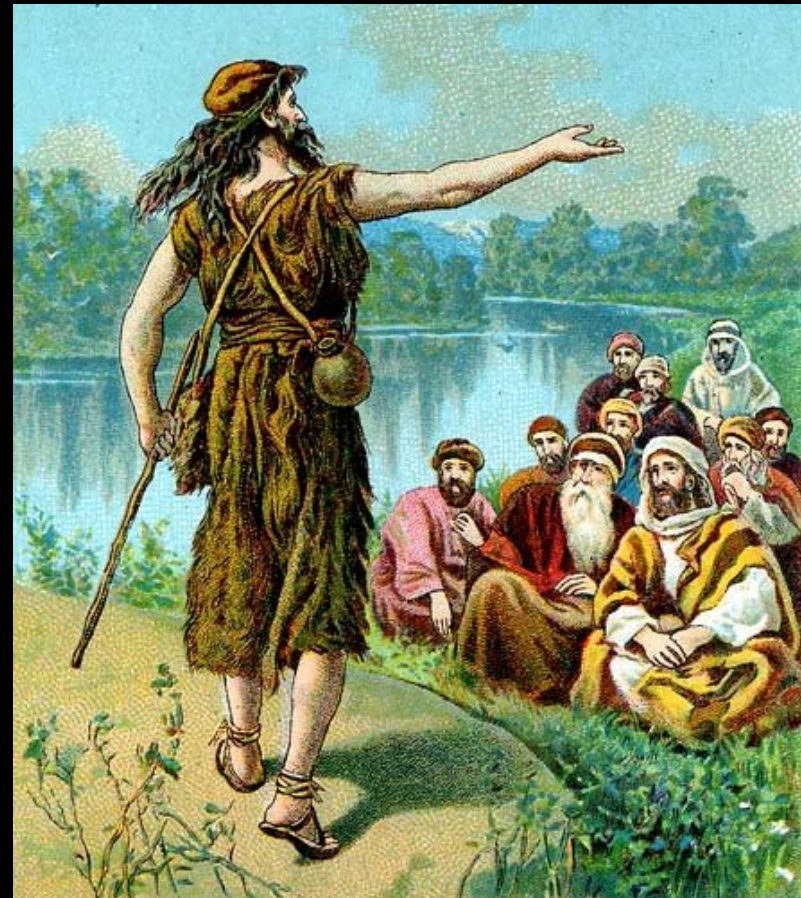
II. Knowing the purpose of the Lamb of God must be shared (v.29).

III. God sent John to baptize so people would know the Lamb of God (v.30-31).

- **How does baptism still reveal Jesus to the world?**



IV. God sent the Spirit so His people would know the Lamb of God (v.32-34).



- What was the role of the Spirit in revealing the Lamb of God to John?
- What is the role of the Spirit in revealing the Lamb of God to us?

V. For us to know the Lamb of God, we must follow Him (v.35-37).



- How well would they have known the Lamb of God if they had not followed Him?
- How well can we know the Lamb of God if we do not follow Him?
- What will it take to convince you to follow the Lamb of God?
