
Knowing Jesus as the Son of Man


John 2:1-11

 When people want their parties to be enjoyable, what kinds of people are invited?


 What does it say about Jesus that both He and His disciples were invited?

- What does it say about Jesus that He chose to help anyway?




IV. Jesus was a man who did an excellent job of blessing others (v.9-10).

 Why would Jesus make better wine than they already had?


 How can we do a better job of blessing others?
