

# Knowing Jesus as the Son of Man

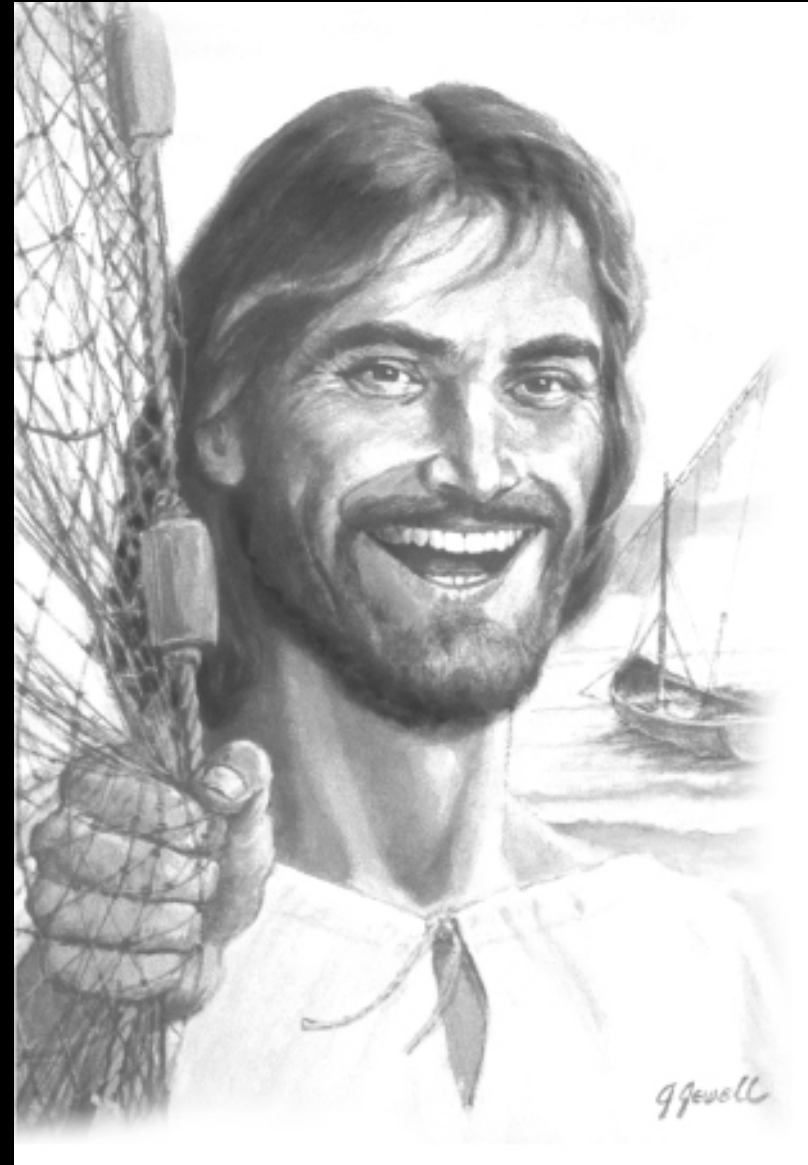
**John 2:1-11**



# I. Jesus was the kind of man who got invited to parties

## -John 2:1-2.

- When people want their parties to be enjoyable, what kinds of people are invited?
- What does it say about Jesus that both He and His disciples were invited?



**II. Jesus was the kind of man you went to for help with a need (v.3-5).**

- What reasons would Mary have to go to Jesus when the wine had run out?
- How can we become the kind of person that others come to when there is a need?





# III. Jesus was a man who helped even when it was not in His schedule (v.4-8).

- How did Jesus show respect to His mother in this situation?
- Why mention, "My time has not yet come." at that time?
- What does it say about Jesus that He chose to help anyway?



## IV. Jesus was a man who did an excellent job of blessing others (v.9-10).

- How did Jesus ensure that common people were aware of His glory?
- Why would Jesus make better wine than they already had?
- How can we do a better job of blessing others?



# V. Jesus the Son of man, chose turning water to wine as His first miracle (v.11).

- Of all the miracles Jesus could have chosen to “reveal His glory” why this one?
- How must we change to better follow this “Son of man?”
