I. The life of Jesus motivated men to come many miles to see Him

–John 12:20-22.



- **Why do you think that these Greeks came all that way to see Jesus?**
- **How does the reply of Jesus help us to know what they were asking?**

II. Jesus knew that He had to die to bear much fruit (v.23-24).



- **How clearly and how often do we see the principle of dying so that life can come?**
- **In what ways do we need to die so that we can bear much fruit?**

III. Jesus called us to deny ourselves and follow Him (v.25-26).



- What parts of our lives do we need to be hating?
- What does it mean for us to be where Jesus would be?

IV. God loudly announced that Jesus glorifies the Father (v.27-30).

- What is the struggle of Jesus here and in the Garden of Gethsemane?
- What would you have experienced if you had been there to hear God's voice?
- How is that voice still uttered for our sakes?



**V. Because Jesus is
'lifted up,' He draws all
men to Him (v.31-36).**



- **How was the world judged, when Jesus was lifted up on the cross?**
- **What will help us to truly become 'sons of light?'**

Call to Action: To die to anything that hinders us from being drawn closer and closer to Jesus.

- What do we need to die to, so we can follow?
- How does the voice of God fill us with awe?
