
KNOWING JESUS, THE BURIED SACRIFICE



JOHN 19:31-42

I. Before our sacrifice was buried, they had to make sure He was dead (John 19:31-34).



 Why did the Jewish leaders want the legs of the three men to be broken?

 How does the reality of the death of Jesus affect you? II. Our buried sacrifice clearly strengthens our faith (v.35-37).

III. Men of faith risked their lives to bury our sacrifice (v.38-40).

IV. Our Savior spent Friday night, Saturday and Sunday morning buried (v.41-42).



• What is the significance of the burial of Jesus (I Corinthians 15:3-4)?

 Where was the center of all spiritual focus while the body of Jesus was buried? V. Jesus calls us to be buried with Him (Romans 6:3-5).



Why is the burial of a Christian so significant?
