- How amazing is the reality of resurrection?


II. Peter and John examined the empty tomb but didn't understand (v.3-9).

- What still amazes you as you see the open tomb?




III. Instead of holding onto Jesus, Mary was told to tell others (v.10-18).

- What convinced Mary that Jesus had been bodily raised?
- What convinces you that Jesus has been bodily raised?
- Why must we tell others instead of merely holding onto Jesus?



IV. The risen Lord turns fear into peace (v.19-20).

- How desperately did those disciples need peace?
- How did the risen Lord offer them His peace?
- How can the presence of the risen Lord give you peace?



Call to Action: To spread the peace of God that can only come from the risen Lord.



- How did the risen Lord grant peace to Mary?
- How did the risen Lord grant peace to the disciples?
- How has the risen Lord offered peace to you?
- How are you going to offer others the peace that only comes from the risen Lord?
