IV. Jesus offers greater blessings to those who walk by faith, not by sight (v.29).



- Why is it a greater blessing to have faith without sight?
- What helps you to have faith in the resurrection and lordship of Jesus?

V. The recorded miracles provide a sufficient foundation for faith (v.30-31).

- How do the written miracles compare to the claimed healings of today?
- How do the recorded miracles of Jesus affect your faith?
- How do the miracles of Jesus help you to have life in His name?
