**I. Jesus walks with us, speaks for us, and atoned for our sins (I John 2:1-2).**

**IV. Jesus wants each of us to serve with the strength we have now (v.12-14).**



- **What does God want little children to do for Him?**
- **What does God desire of strong, young men and women?**
- **How does God describe His more mature followers?**
