

I. Adam and Eve were a family before they had children (Gen. 2:22-25).




 Why is it important for marriage to be the strongest bond in a home?

II. In the same home, Abel learned to offer his best but Cain did not (4:1-4).


 How can two brothers learn different values in the same home?
