
## THE JOY OF THE LORD IS YOUR STRENGTH




**NEHEMIAH 8:8-12**

 How does anxiety turn to joy whenever we understand our responsibilities? II. There is a tendency toward sadness when we hear God's word (v.9).




 When we realize how far we have fallen from God's will, why are we sad?
