


# THE RIVER OF THE WATER OF LIFE

22




I. The river of the water of life flows from the throne of God

- What is our role in the work of the river of life and of the tree of life?




# III. The promise for the redeemed was that the Lamb is coming soon (v.6-13).

- How can we know that Jesus was coming soon for the seven churches of Asia?


(Revelation 1:1, 3; 22:6, 7, 10, 12, 20)
