**I. The apostles
experienced Jesus so
we can enjoy fellowship
with them (I John 1:1-4).**

II. We have to choose to walk in light instead of in darkness (v.5-6).



- How should the purity of God affect how we live?

- How do we try to fool ourselves into thinking that it is OK to sin?

III. God promises continued cleansing to those who walk in the light (v.7).



- How can fallen man walk in the light like Jesus did?
- What happens when we sin while we are walking in the light?
- Why is it so important to have assurance of forgiveness?

IV. Genuine confession allows us to be cleansed of all our sin (v.8-10).



- What is accomplished by our attempts to hide or deny our sin?
- Why is confession so effective in moving God to forgive?
- How can an increased desire for fellowship with Jesus motivate confession?
