II CORINTHIANS 5:14-17

I. Christ's love compels those who are convinced of His sacrifice (v.14).



All the major translations agree: -"because we have concluded this" -ESV; "because we are convinced" -NIV; "having concluded this" - NAS; "because we thus judge" -KJV

II. Christ's love compels those who are convinced that we died with Him (v.14).



 What behaviors will help you to be convinced that you have died with Christ?

 What behaviors will follow your assurance that you have died with Christ? III. Christ died so that we would live for Him and not for ourselves (v.15).



 What does this verse say about the effect of the death of Christ on selfish lives?

 How can our selfless example better honor the One who died for us? IV. If we believe this, we do not value people on a worldly scale (v.16).



 When Christ has convinced us, how do we view and value the world around us?

 How do our actions betray the level of our spiritual conviction? V. We are convinced and conclude that everything is new in Christ (v.17).



 What does this perspective have to do with past failures or glories?

 How well are we living in the present for the future?
