

HEART PROBLEMS


CHARACTERISTICS OF A HEART OF STONE:

 - Unwilling to consideralternatives

 - Christians are struggling to identify their faith as adding value to society











GOD BREATHES LIFE

- ▶ Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God has made me, And the breath of the Almighty gives life."




THE HUMAN BODY:

- Began with 2 cells
- Multiplies to around 37.2 trillion cells
- Cells are held together by a protein called "laminin" that is essential to all organfunction



LAMININ

A cell adhesion protein molecule found in the "extracellular matrix", the sheets of protein that form the substrate of all internal organs also called the "basement membrane". Laminin is vital to making sure overall body structures **hold together**. -Wiki


