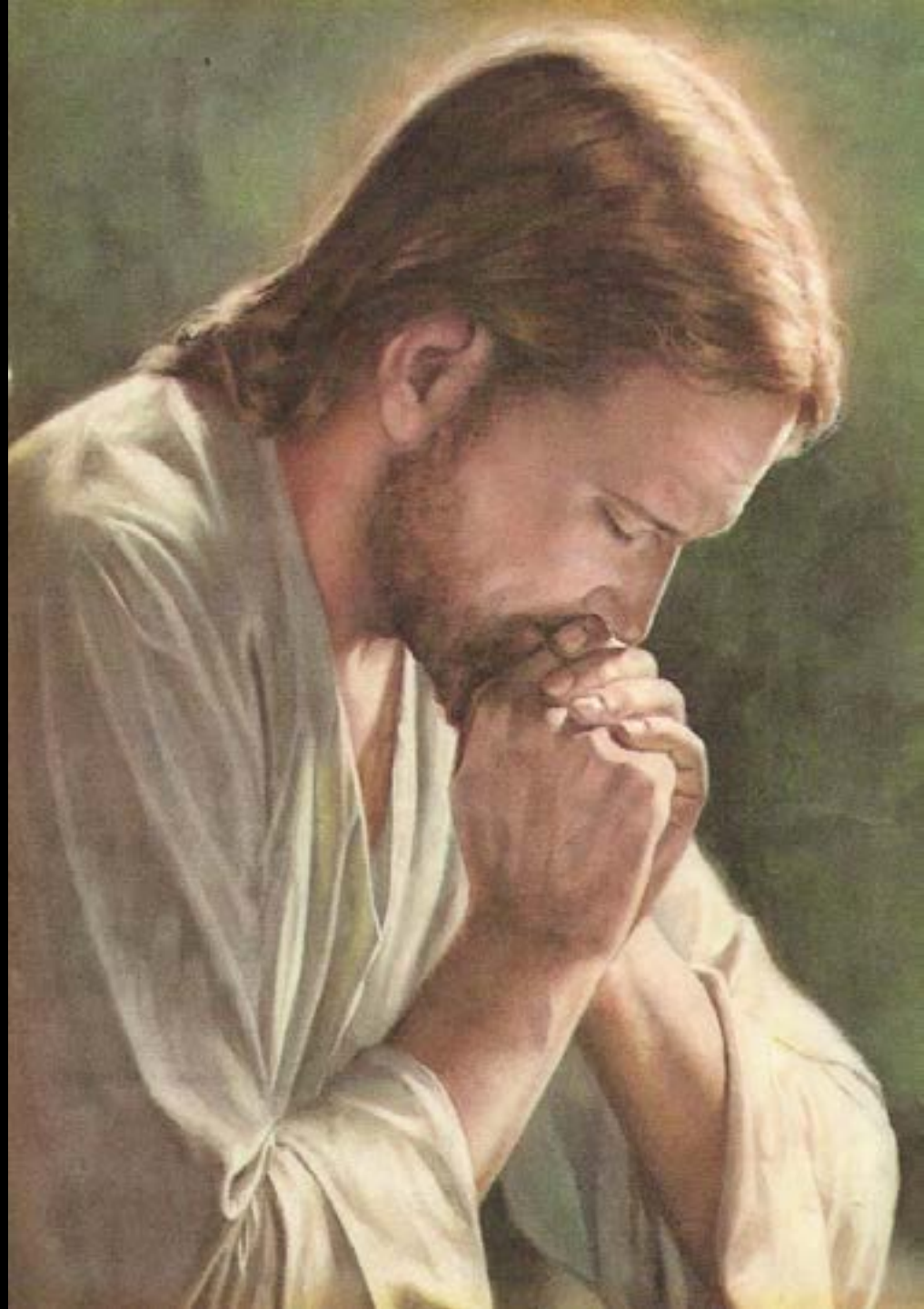


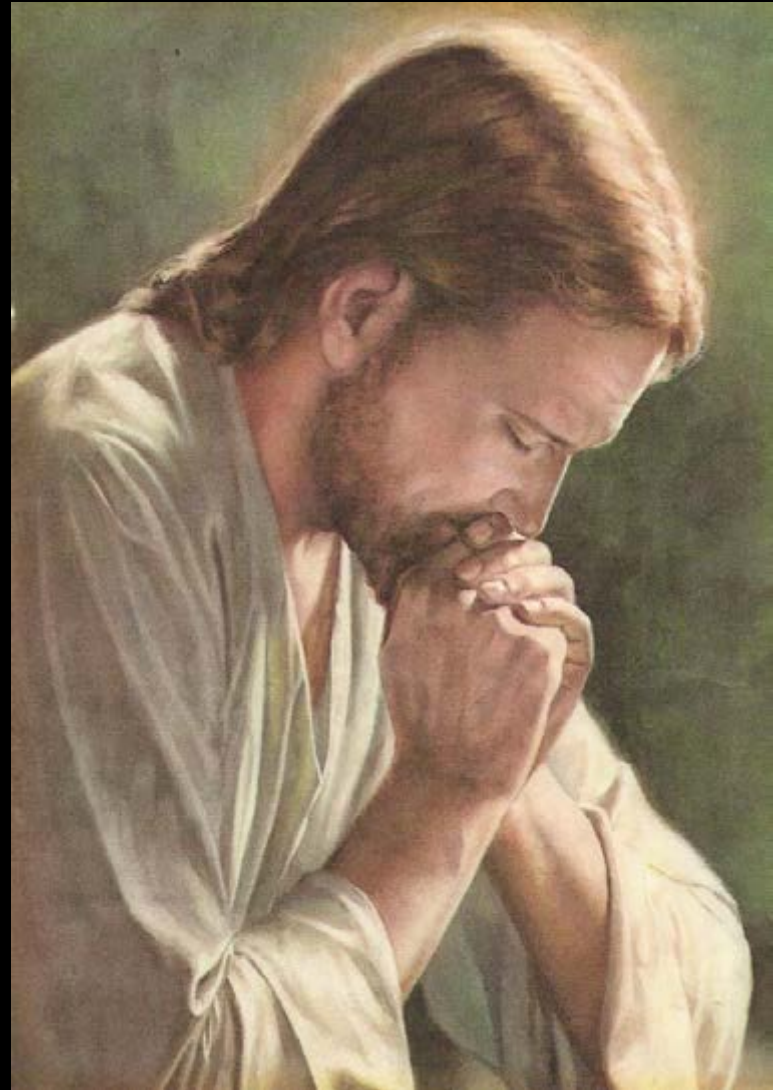
THE REAL LORD'S PRAYER

JOHN 17



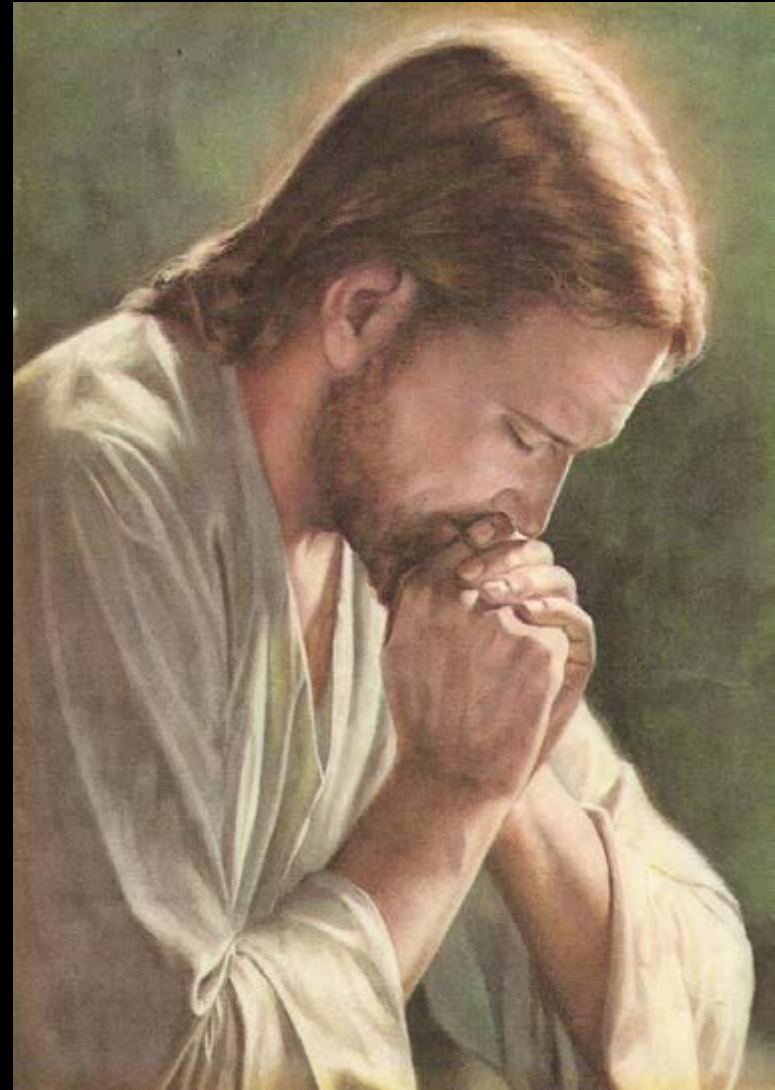
I. This is how Jesus prayed for Himself (John 17:1-5).

- **For what purposes should we be praying for ourselves?**



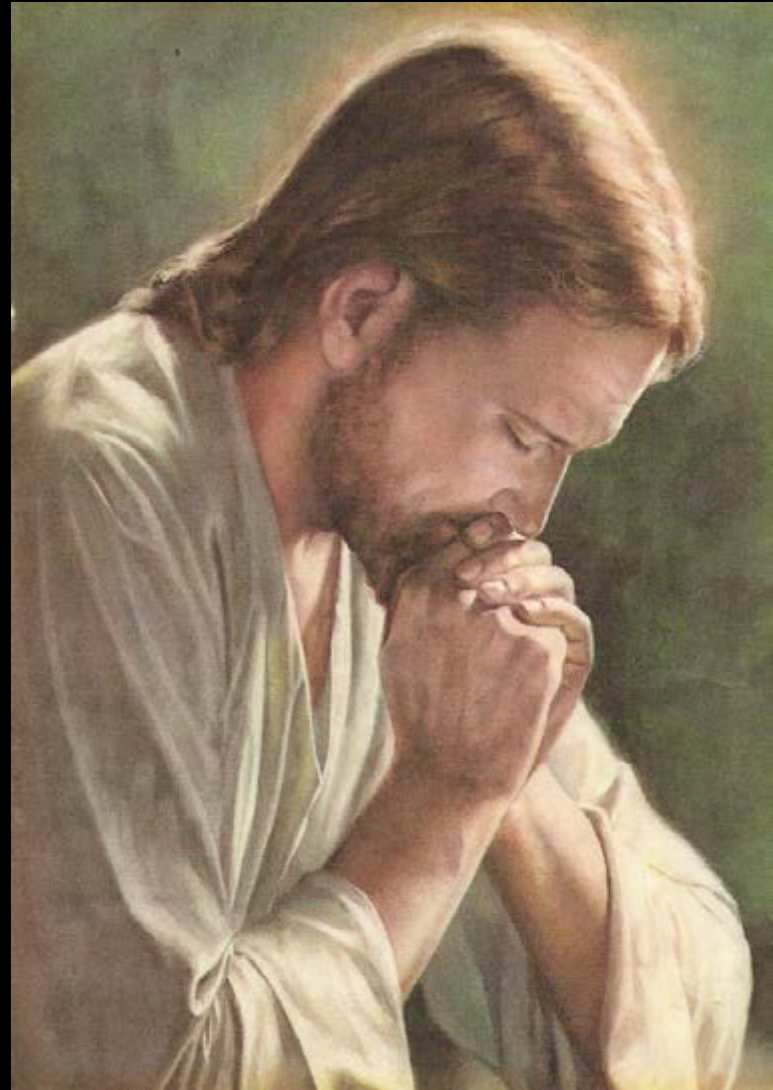
II. This is how Jesus prayed for His disciples (John 17:6-19).

- **What would change if we prayed these blessings for our brethren?**



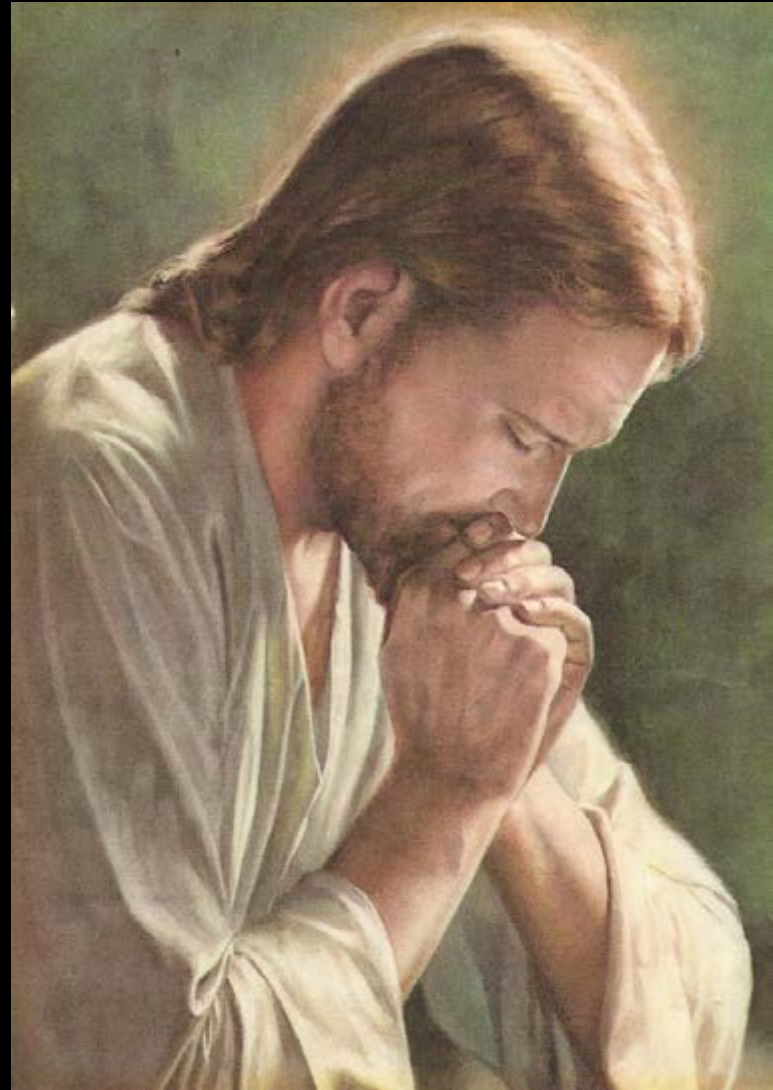
III. This is how Jesus prayed for all of us (John 17:20-26).

- **What happens when we pray for God's love to be in our brethren?**



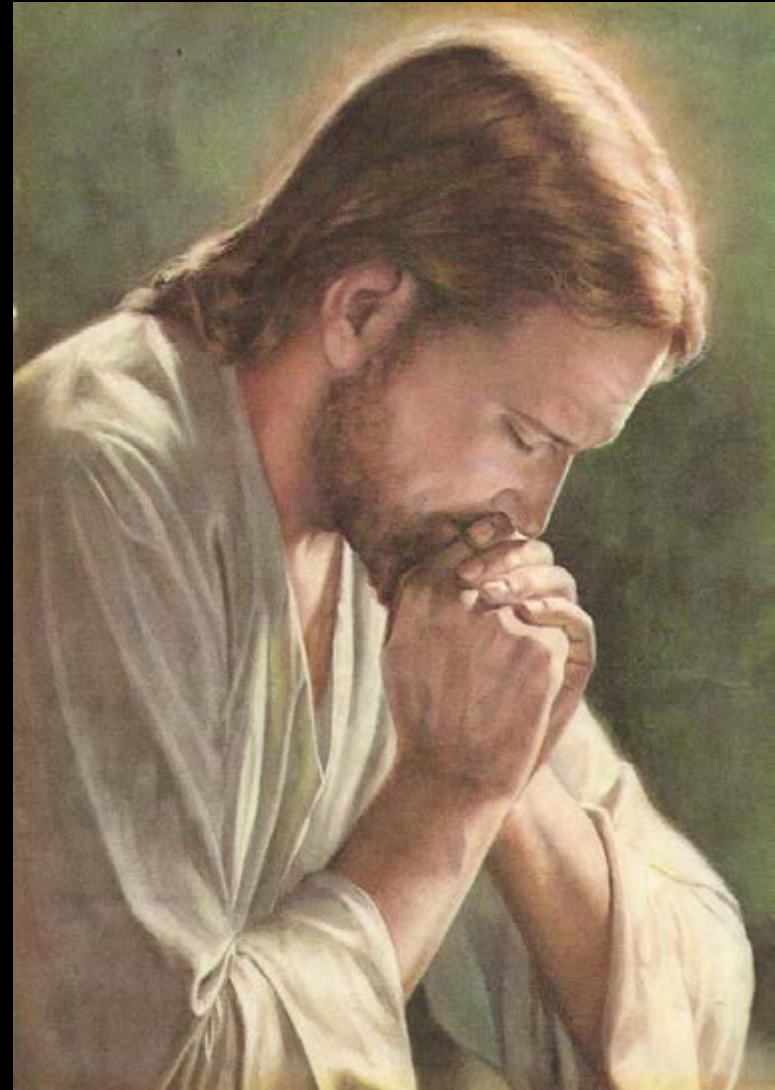
IV. This is how the early disciples prayed (Colossians 1:9-12).
