I. Any law system is incapable of making anything perfect (Hebrews 7:18-19).



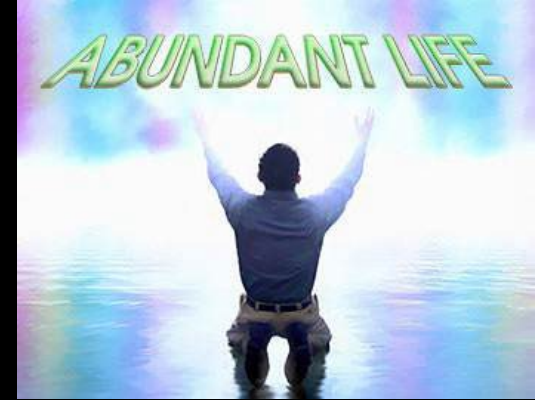
- What is the fault with any law system (8:8)?

IV. Our better hope has received a permanent priesthood (Hebrews 7:23-24).



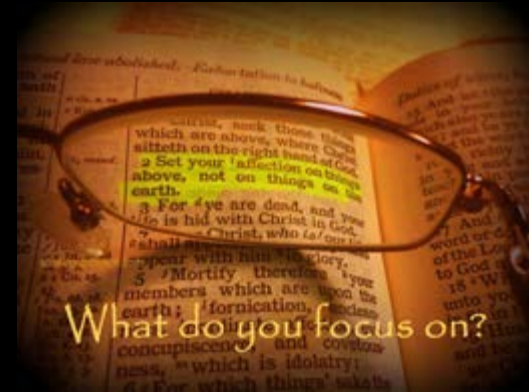
- **How does the mortality of human priests limit our hope?**

V. Our better hope continues to save us to the uttermost **(Hebrews 7:25)**.
