True Or False?

Definition: Properly, to distinguish, i.e. Decide (mentally or judicially); by implication, to try, condemn, punish... (Strong's)

A man and his wife with a hearing problem.

Examples

Days and eats – Romans 14:5

A greater debt and love – Luke 7:43

How we relate to each other – Romans 14:13

Condemn before hearing – Luke 7:51

Right judgment – John 7:24

Christian censures? – Matthew 7:1

Text And Context

Matthew 7:1-6

"Do not judge, that not too you will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you..

"Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother or sister's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? How can you say to your brother or sister,

Matthew 7:1-6

'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you can see clearly to remove the speck from your brother or sister's eye.

Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet and then turn and tear you to pieces."
